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Office:

If you come directly to our office **ONLY** one person will be allowed in at a time, due to social distancing requirements.

Local Health District:

A drive-thru screening has been set up to give healthcare providers another option for patients experiencing symptoms consistent with COVID-19. It is not a self-referral, guaranteed testing site.

If you are concerned that you may have the novel coronavirus (COVID-19), before asking to be screened for testing ask yourself:

- Within the past two weeks, have you traveled to a high-risk country (China, South Korea, Italy, Iran) or been in close contact with someone else who has traveled to a high-risk county?
- Have you been in close contact with someone who tested positive for COVID-19 within the last two weeks?
- Are you a healthcare provider or first responder who helped care for a person who was confirmed positive for COVID-19 within the last two weeks?
- Do you have symptoms similar to those of COVID-19 such as a high fever – AND - cough, or shortness of breath – AND – answered yes to one of the above questions?

If yes, you will still need to take the step listed below, before utilizing the drive-thru screening site.

1) Call the office, if your call is not immediately answered, leave a detailed message and one of our providers will call you back within the hour to assess and screen your symptoms.

The drive-thru screening will be held at the Spokane Fairgrounds beginning Friday March 20th from 10:00am – 8:00pm until further notice, based on resources.
